## Year 1 Phonics Screening Check - 2019

<b>School</b>	<b>87</b>	At the end of Year 1 children are tested on their ability to match sounds with letters. This is known as the Phonics Screening Check. This tests phonological awareness and understanding of sound-letter correspondence which is a key early reading skill. Being able to use phonological awareness is not the only way children learn to read but being good at phonics is considered to be an important starting point.
