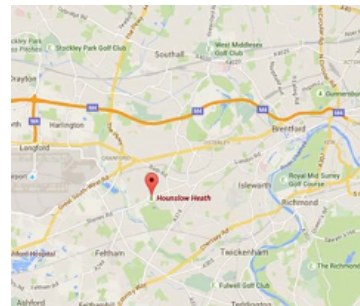

Vocabulary

United Kingdom	A country that includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland
Europe	Is made up of 44 different countries. It is the 2 nd largest continent.
Country	A country is land that is controlled by a single government.
city	A place where people live that is larger than a town.
town	A place where people live that is smaller than a city but bigger than a village. A place with many streets and buildings, where people live and work.
village	A small community in a countryside area.
Settlement	A place where people have come to live and have built homes.
Human features	things like houses, roads and bridges. They have been built by people.
Physical features	Physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural. They would be here even if there were no people around.
