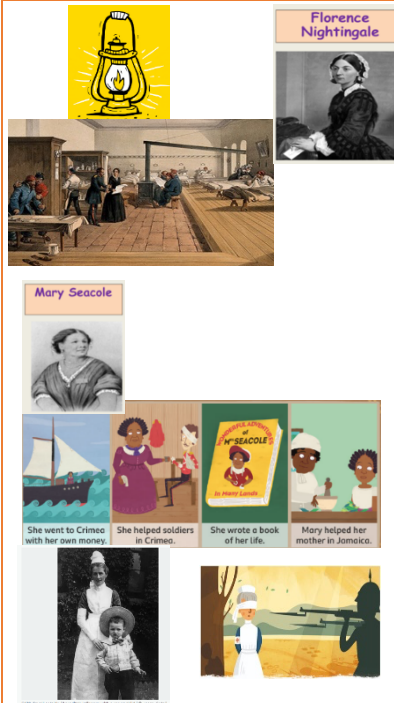

Vocabulary

Crimean War	(1853-1856) A war between Russia on one side and Britain, France, the Ottoman Empire (now Turkey, officially the Republic of <i>Türkiye</i>) and Sardinia on the other.
battlefield	A place where soldiers fight in war.
First World War	(1914-1918) First World War or World War I.
hospital	A building where doctors and nurses take care of people who are ill or injured.
nurse	Somebody who takes care of people who are sick or injured.
patients	People who are being looked after by nurses and doctors.
soldier	Men or women who fight in an army
conflict	disagreement
prejudice	Treating people differently, normally not very nicely, because of the colour of their skin or religion.
sanitation	Keeping things clean, especially by washing
