The menu is both on the website & on parentpay. Speak to your child about what they will be eating the following day and then please book your child's meal on parent pay— the meal is free but needs to be ordered in advance the day/evening before by you on parentpay. The Mayor's pledge means children from year 3 to year 6 get a free meal by telling their teacher in the morning when registered that they would like a school dinner that day but what they are eating is your choice and must be ordered in advance by you on parentpay.

The government already gives a free meal to Reception to year 2 and this should be ordered daily on parentpay as above. If your child prefers they can still bring a healthy packed lunch instead.

Please ensure you have no meal debt on parentpay from last term as this will pre-vent you booking your child's free meal

Orchard Primary is located within a zone where traffic is restricted at the start and end of the school day.


> The School Street operates Monday—Friday during term time: 8.15am-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm
