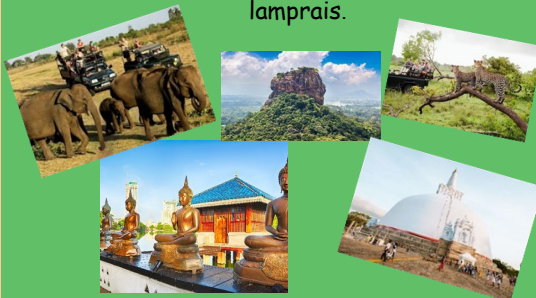
Where in the world is Miss Arri?
