The first cross country race was for Year 5 and 6 girls, followed by the boys race. Mrs. Brown helped us warm up by jogging on the spot and doing some stretchers.

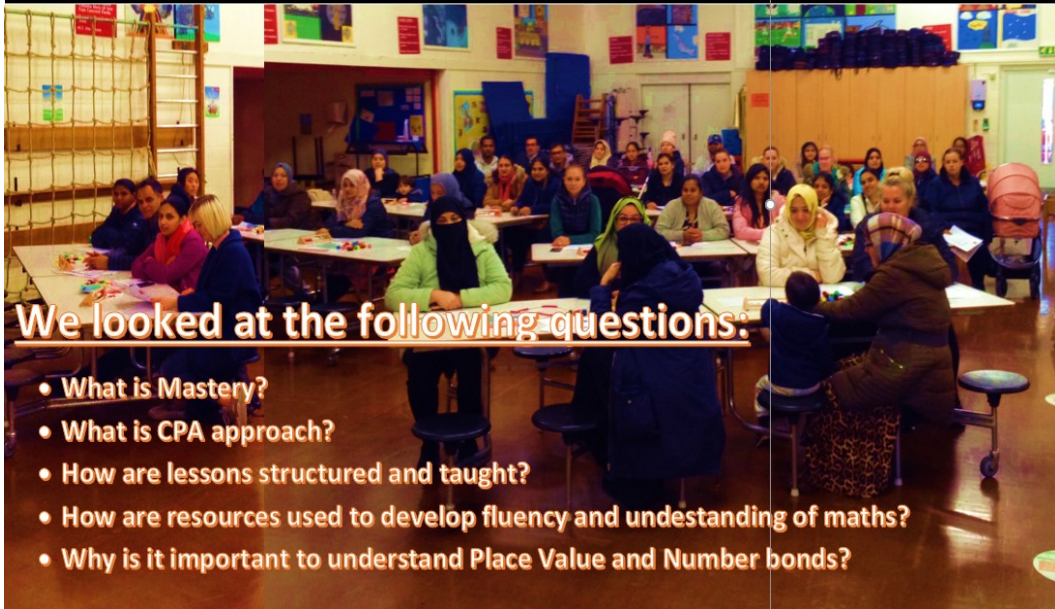
We all felt nervous but we ran the best we could and at the end were all exhausted! We arrived back at school in time for lunch and to tell our friends where we came in our race.
