#### Punctuality

Gates open at 8.45am. Children can go straight into class at this time.

- Key Stage 2 children MUST be in class by 8.55am.
- Key Stage 1 children MUST be in class by 9.00am.

Please be on time to school. Being late disrupts the start of the class and can make your child miss out on important lessons and time with their classmates.

the hospital, please provide an appointment card, hospital discharge letter or
email details (appointment & time) to
the absence email. This is needed so
absence can be authorised.

If collecting early to take your child to an appointment, please also include this in your email.
