This week I have flown South West from Kyrgyzstan to a country in Africa. This country is a small island country - the total size is 4,033 km² (1,557 sq mì) Lleff a millian nonlo live

mi). Half a million people live here. The landscape varies from dry plains to high active volcanoes with cliffs rising steeply from the ocean. The climate is arid.

The culture is built on music, storytelling and food the only ways enslaved people transported here could
express themselves under Portuguese rule. These
days, islanders still sing as they work, strum the
violao (a classical guitar) after dinner, and celebrate
Carnival and saints' fiestas with
an African flourish.

The national dish for this coun-

try is Cachupa, A stew made from many herbs and spices.

This country speaks Portuguese, as it was once was a colony of Portugal. Speaking of colonies, it gained independence from Portugal on July 5th 1975.
