Coronavirus – School Closure

The school will be closed to almost all children from Friday 20th March 2020 until further notice. As advised by the government, we will do all we can to stay open for the children of key workers (e.g. NHS staff, police, others in front-line services) and children with certain needs.

Please email the school absence line – absence@tops.hounslow.sch.uk if you think your child may fall into one of these categories, giving your child's full name and class. We will be in touch again as soon as we are sure who this does apply to.

All other children will need to stay at home, so we ask that you do not send your child into school from Monday 23rd March onwards.

Please note that this is a national closure – as you may have heard in the news – so while it is a challenging situation, we are not alone. We'll re-open fully as soon as we can and will let you know when this is by School Ping, the school website and Text.

During the school closure we will be using "School Ping", our Communications App to keep you updated with information from the school. If you have not already downloaded the app and logged on please do so as soon as possible. If you need assistance with the School Ping App or need to contact us during the closure please send an email to absence@tops.hounslow.gov.uk

Your child's learning is of course important to us, so we'll continue to help your child to learn.

Teachers will be setting work each week which the children will be able to access via DB Primary and will be in touch with more information about the organisation for this including login information.

If your child usually receives free school meals, we will also be in touch with more information about how we will continue to provide this with support from a scheme that the government has just announced.
