Thank you to all year 4 pupils, parents and carers for their generous donations to the foodbank. It is very much appreciated and the foodbank coordinator, in a letter to the school, has acknowledged this.

Hope Church currently runs foodbanks at both its locations – at St Paul’s (Bath Road) on Wednesday mornings and at the Good Shepherd (Beavers Lane) on Thursday mornings. **By the end of 2022, we had served over 3,900 guests and provided enough food to feed over 11,000 adults and children** during the course of the year

(as well as providing toiletries and hygiene products).

As a result, we get through a great deal of stock each week - so your donations are incredibly important to us and, of course, to the people we help.

In the coming weeks we will be collecting donations for the Foodbank from Year 3 and would be very grateful for any donations however small.
