


Orchard Primary School Easter Egg Raffle.



That means it is surrounded by land and does not have it's own access to the sea. This country has a rough alpine terrain and is elevated 1,486 feet above sea level.



The flag of this country is blue and red with a yellow crown. It is a principality - it is ruled by a Prince! He lives in Schloss Vaduz - an amazing

castle which sits on a hilltop and overlooks the capital city of Vaduz. I've had to brush

up on my German because that is the language that is spoken here. There is so much to see in the capital such as the Kathedrale St Florin, Postmuseum, Town Hall and Red House.
