### <u>The Globetrotting Guild of</u> <u>Orchard</u> Primary School (GGOPS)

Yes, last week it was Lithuania. Did you guess correctly?



Where in the world is Hamid? This week I'm in the last country to abolish slavery. In historical times the country was settled by sub-Saharan people. More than 16.6% of the population lives below the extreme poverty line. Arabic is the official language spoken in this country, French is widely spoken especially by the educated. The majority of the population is Muslim, since Islam is the sole religion of

the state. This country was occupied by France up to 1960. This country is most rich in: iron ore, gold, copper, gypsum and phosphate rocks. I also visited the

Richat Structure.



When I spoke to a native they explained gazelles, ostriches, warthogs, panthers, hyenas and lynx are commonly found here. Lions are

confirmed to be extinct in this country. Fish is the main source of protein among the inhabitants.

I've eaten some great dishes here, including: awarikh (dates), thieboudienne (cheb-ujin), a coastal dish of fish and

rice, is considered the national dish, served in a white and red sauce, usually made from tomatoes, méchoui, whole roasted lamb and samak mutabal (spiced fish).
