Rock, a 725m-tall monolith outside the capital of Abuja that's pictured on the national currency (the naira). Many people

think that Lagos is the capital city but it is actually Abuja. The official language spoken is English.



I've been enjoying the cuisine; many dishes are made from locally sourced ingredients, such as cassava, yams, plantains, pineapple,

maize, beans, and palm oil. These ingredients form the staple diet and are used to prepare a variety of dishes, such as jollof rice, pounded yam and egusi soup, and fufu.

marks such as; The Abuja

National Mosque and Bower's Tower.
