
The Globetrotting Guild of Orchard Primary School (GGOPS)



Last week's country was Jamaica. Did you guess correctly?

This week I've flown North East to the Great Northern European Plain. This country's topography is typically flat in coastal regions and hilly in the inland southeastern part of the country. This country ranks second in Europe for bird diversity. I've spotted six species of eagle, and eight of the nine European woodpecker species in Matsalu National Park and Nõva Nature Reserve.

I toured the fairytale-like Medieval Tallinn, including sites such as Toompea Hill, Kiek in de Kok and the winding cobblestone streets of Old Town.







I've enjoyed all the culinary delights that this country has to offer. Alongside bread, other staples include potatoes and pork. You'll also find quite a few dairy products like sour cream, cheese, kefir, milk, and yogurt. Additionally, people here eat lots of fish, such as herring, pikeperch, or smoked

fish.
