School Lunches

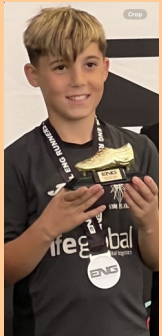
Please book your child's school meal on Parent pay before the day lunch is needed.
