Collective Worship

In the past, we have applied for a **Determination** which allows us to have collective worship which reflects not only the Christian faith, but also the faiths and customs of our wider school community.

Without our Determination the expectation would be that our collective worship should be 'wholly or mainly of a broadly Christian character'. The Determination enables us to value, reflect and promote the cultural, linguistic and religious diversity of the school population.

This year we need to apply for renewal of the Determination to allow for acts of worship to be relevant and meet the needs of our diverse community. The Determination provides an exemption for the whole school from the requirement that the majority of acts of worship must be 'wholly or mainly of a broadly Christian character'. This does not mean that the Christian Faith is not reflected but means that we are also able to consider other traditions, customs and beliefs.
