Freezing:

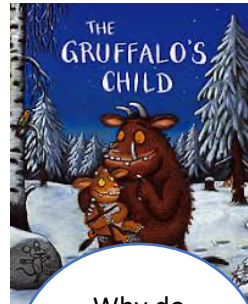
When it is very cold, water change from a liquid to a solid (ice)

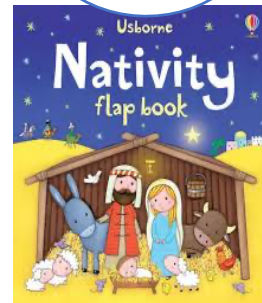

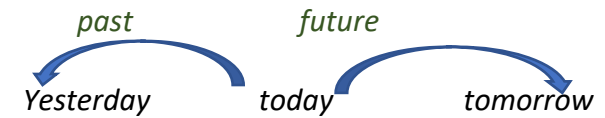
