Communication & Language

- Pupils will be talking about family, routines and meals.
- Describing their families, festivals, significant events in their lives.
- Use props to role play some stories and scenarios.

Literacy

- Children will listen to stories being read to them and talk about reading.
- Children will begin Phase 2 phonics.
- Children will learn nursery rhymes and poems.
- We will listen to a range of stories

Mathematics

- Count forwards and backwards, starting from different numbers.
- Able to find a small number from a larger group of objects
- Know the last number counted is the total of group.
- Be able to notice patterns.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- The children will be developing their ability to take turns and share with one another.
- They will begin to learn and understand school rules.
